accommodation (noun)	a place to live or to stay in
accounts (noun) [pl]	a record of all the money that a person or business has received or paid out
action-packed (adj)	full of exciting events and activity
advice (noun)	an opinion that you give sb about what he/she should do
advise (verb)	to tell sb what you think they should do
agency (noun)	a business that provides a particular service
aggressive (adj)	ready or likely to fight or argue
airline (noun)	a company that sells flights for people or things in an aeropla
aisle (noun)	a passage between the rows of seats on a plane
apartment (noun)	a set of rooms rented for a holiday
applicant	a person who applies for sth, especially a job, a place at a university, etc.
application (noun)	a formal written request, especially for a job, a place at a university, etc.
apply (verb)	apply (to sb) (for sth) to ask for sth formally, in writing, especially a job
appropriate (adj)	suitable or right for a particular situation, person, use
arrangement (noun)	plan or preparation that you make so that sth can happen
arrival (noun)	the act of coming or being brought to a place
attraction (noun)	an interesting or enjoyable place to go or thing to do
awareness (noun)	knowledge that sth exists and is important; interest in sth
